The school is founded to honour this noble soul from the hamlet of Kudamaloor and to impart schooling according to the lofty academic ideals this cloistered nun cherished in her life. Established in the year 2007, this institution adheres to the catholic policy on secular education which counts schools as extended arms of the Church.

St. Alphonsa Public School & Junior College has its own tastefully architected multi-storeyed buildings with proper class rooms, laboratories, library cum reading room etc. Each floor has separate toilets for girls and boys. 
Co-curricular Activities
